CLINICAL TRAINING APPLICATION DEADLINES

Application Available	Application Deadline	Timing of Clinical Training*
November 30, 2018	January 11, 2019	most will train the following summer
March 3, 2019	April 15, 2019	most will train in fall
June 3, 2019	July 15, 2019	most will train in winter
September 3, 2019	October 15, 2019	most will train the following spring

* MAP encourages applicants to apply 3 - 6 months in advance of when they want to train.

OVERVIEW OF MAP'S 2019 CLINICAL TRAINING APPLICATION PROCESS

- ✱ Eligible applicants are physicians, advanced practice clinicians, nurses, and students/trainees of these professions.
- ✱ Applications must be completed online through a secure survey system. A link to access the application will be posted on MAP's website.
- ✱ All applicants will be notified 2 weeks after the deadline whether they have received a training slot.
- ✱ In addition to the four general application cycles, MAP may offer up to two special application cycles throughout the year. Eligible applicants are Advanced Practice Clinicians, APC nursing students, and practicing physicians. The cycles will target these groups' special training and scheduling needs.
